• Provide support for assigned students during Learning Labs and during class:

- Monitor student progress and assist students in identifying outstanding assignments, focusing on students identified as being at risk of academic failure
- Procure and monitor use of Chromebooks or other computer technology
- Communicate with teachers regarding student progress and support needs
- Serve as a "quiet room" for students in need of alternative workspace as assigned
- Maintain files of assessments, project descriptions, and other student materials and follow up with students to complete during learning labs or other appropriate times
- Support testing accommodations as needed
- Recruit and coordinate volunteer tutors
- Provide direct support to instruction as assigned
- Coordinate student support activities with other professionals, such as special education teachers, related service staff, general education teachers and specialists
- Assist with maintaining student records and reporting
- Supervise student lunch and movement periods
- All other duties as assigned by the Principal
